

Ferrell G. Tolman

TEN SLEEP — Ferrell G. "Tuffy" Tolman, 74, of Ten Sleep, died Sunday, June 14, in Ten Sleep.

He was born May 4, 1918, in Ten Sleep, a son of Cyrus Emery and Janie (Harris) Tolman. He was raised in Ten Sleep and attended schools there.

He then went to work on the family ranch until moving to Seattle, Wash. to work for Boeing during World War II.

On July 26, 1943, he married Esther Daugherty in Portland, Ore.

In 1946, the couple returned to Ten Sleep to work on the Tolman Ranch and in 1952, they moved to the Daugherty Ranch. In 1954, they moved to Renton, Wash. to work for Boeing, eventually moving back to Ten Sleep where they bought a ranch next to the Daugherty Ranch east of Ten Sleep. They eventually operated both ranches.

Following their retirement, the couple moved to Ten Sleep. She died

Jan. 18.

Mr. Tolman was an avid rockhound and prospector.

Survivors include three nephews, Jerry Tolman of Albuquerque, N.M., Alan L. Tolman of Worland and Brett Tolman of Cheyenne and one niece, Valerie Tolman of Colorado Springs. He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, Jerry and Calvin.

The service is scheduled for 1:30 p.m. Thursday in the Veile Mortuary Chapel in Worland, with the Rev. Keith Schafer of the Ten Sleep Assembly of God Church officiating. Burial will be at 3 p.m. Thursday in the Ten Sleep Cemetery.
